Temporary restrictions on the entry of visitors to Indonesia

As per the circular number IMI-GR.01.01-0873, from Minister of Law and Human Rights of the Republic of Indonesia, Director General of Immigration, in the context of preventing the imported cases of COVID-19:

- (i) Immigration Officers at the Immigration Checkpoints will refuse entry to foreigners who have a history of travel from Indian territory within 14 (fourteen) days before entering Indonesian territory;
- (ii) The provision of visitor visas and limited stay visas for Indian citizens is temporarily suspended.
- (iii) This policy has been implemented with effect from April 24, 2021 and will be further evaluated.
